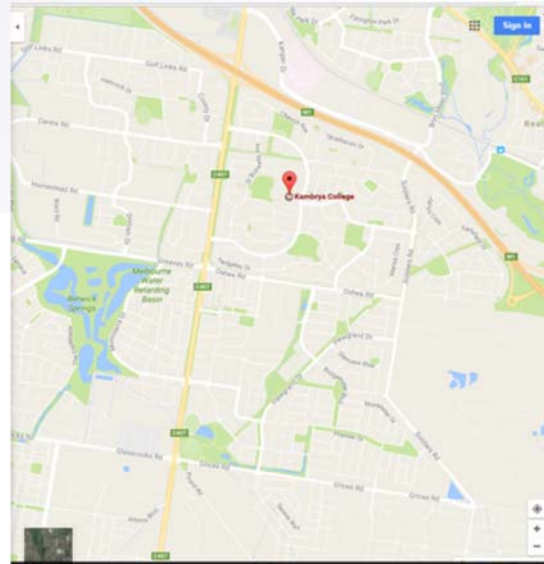

22338VIC Certificate II in Building and Construction Pre-apprenticeship (Carpentry) is for students who wish to build their practical experience and knowledge to ensure their employment opportunities as an Apprentice Carpenter.

Carpenters are the key players in domestic house construction - they are usually the first on site, and the last to leave.

While Carpenters have their specific skills and tasks to perform in the building process, Carpenters must have knowledge of all other trades, as a Carpenter's work often accommodates the other trades who follow them.

Our 22338VIC Certificate II in Building and Construction Pre-apprenticeship (Carpentry) covers all skills and knowledge required for domestic building, at the entry level, including instruction and supervised use of tools and equipment used by Carpenters.
