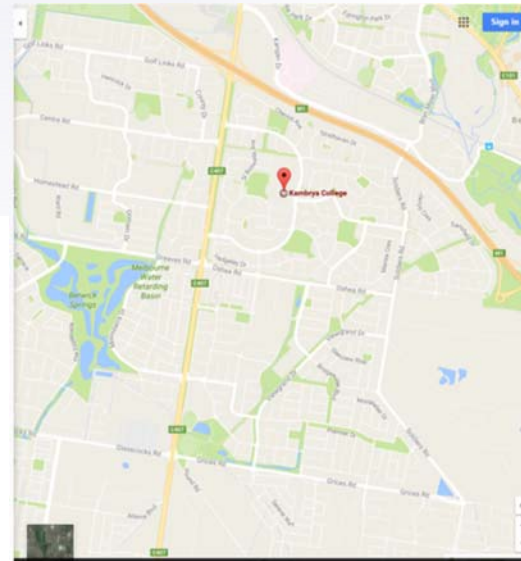

Contribution to VCE/VCAL

VCE Credit: you will be eligible for up to four units towards your VCE: two units at Units 1 and 2 level, and a Units 3 and 4 sequence. A study score is available, which can contribute directly towards your ATAR - either as one of your best four studies (the primary four) or as your fifth or sixth study.

VCAL Credits: you will be eligible for up to four credits towards your VCAL- at the Intermediate or Senior levels.

VET Sport & Recreation

This two-year program will offer students the opportunity to undertake a Certificate III qualification whilst completing their VCE or VCAL classes. The program will introduce the student to the employment and educational opportunities within the SPORT & RECREATION industry. The focus of the program will be on developing skills, knowledge and confidence in a variety of practical settings. This course is ideal if you are considering a career such as a sports and recreation officer, fitness instructor, physical education teacher or sporting coach. Students will also develop knowledge of the sporting industry and relevant workplace skills. Students will learn about the preparation and equipment required for sporting and recreation sessions, how to conduct these sessions, first aid and how to deal with clients. The second year of the course has a focus on fitness training and instruction. Students will develop leadership and organisational skills through theory and practical sessions. These skills are put into practice through the organisation of several excursion programs, including a surfing trip and a ski camp. These are essential practical components to successfully meet the outcomes of the certificate.
