# **Statement of Values and School Philosophy**

The school aims to prepare students to contend with a dynamic 21st century in which creativity, cooperative work, connectedness to the world and adaptability are key features.

The school values <u>Achievement, Integrity, Respect</u> and <u>Compassion</u>; believing in having high expectations for all students and a commitment to hard work.

### Implementation of school philosophy:

Kambrya College is committed to providing a safe, supportive and inclusive environment for all students, staff and members of our community. Our school recognises the importance of the partnership between our school and parents and carers to support student learning, engagement and wellbeing. We share a commitment to, and a responsibility for, creating an inclusive and safe school environment for our students.

In accordance the principles outlined in the *Education and Training Reform Act 2006* (Vic), as a Victorian government school, the programs of, and teaching at Kambrya College will support and promote the principles and practices of Australian democracy including a commitment to:
