

## Form 2: notice of election and call for nominations

An election is to be conducted for members of the school council of **Kambrya College**.

**Nomination forms** may be obtained from the school and **must be lodged, along with the Candidate's Statement\* by 4.00pm on Monday, 4<sup>th</sup> March 2024.**

If required, the ballot will close at 4.00pm on Wednesday, 20<sup>th</sup> March 2024.

Following the closing of nominations, a list of the nominations received will be posted at the school.

The terms of office, membership categories and number of positions in each membership category open for election are as follows:

If the number of nominations is less than the number of vacancies, a notice to that effect and calling for further nominations will be posted in a prominent position at the school.

### Statements from candidates\*

In line with standard election procedure, the principal invites candidates to prepare a brief statement of no more than 150 words to be distributed if a ballot is required. This allows each electorate to gain some background about the people standing for election.

A statement from a candidate may include information about their:

- work experience, including voluntary work
- academic and professional qualifications, if applicable
- skills and abilities including those that may be useful to the council
- previous and current involvement with the school, and school council including subcommittees of school council
- reasons for standing for election
- interests and hobbies
